Equipment Requirements

- PAT Kit
Didac will supply a PAT kit for training. If you have your own and would like guidance on how to operate it please bring it with you.
- Electrical Equipment

A broader range of equipment will add to the quality of training and make for a more interesting and informative session.
- Office / Classroom / Cabin
A well-lit and suitably heated closed door environment to conduct theory training. Tables and chairs to accommodate all learners and the trainer assessor, this must include writing space for all learners. A screen or projector is desirable but not essential.
